MEDICAL OFFICER (KARACHI INSTITUTE OF KIDNEY DISEASES) JAN 2024 – JUNE 2024

Worked as a Medical Officer in General Medicine department with Nephrology, Elderly care and Cardiology as subspeciality. Managing patients of Diabetes and its complications, Pneumonia, Upper and Lower Respiratory Tract Infections, Metabolic acidosis/alkalosis, Acute and Chronic kidney injury, Acute Pyelonephritis, UTI, Bladder Outflow Obstruction, Heart Failure, Anemic Failure etc. I'm being rotated to ICU and Emergency department as well. My duties includes patient's assessment and immediate management, investigation and diagnosis, maintaining patient records, resuscitation, making discharge summaries and referral notes. I perform and assist in procedures like intravenous cannulation, blood sampling, arterial blood gases (ABGs), urinary catheterizations, nasogastric tube placement, intubation and bladder wash.

In addition to clinical duties, I prioritize patient education, ensuring they understand their conditions, treatment options, and preventive measures.

MEDICAL OFFICER (SINDH GOVT. LYARI GENERAL HOSPITAL) MAY 2023 – DEC 2023

Worked in General Medicine department under the supervision of consultant. Daily bed-side morning rounds and morning meetings were conducted. My daily responsibilities were taking detailed history and performing relevant systemic examination, medical assessments, reviewing diagnostic tests, and following treatment plans. I/V cannulation, blood sampling, NG Tube insertion and catheterization were performed. As part of my duty, I have been posted to ICU to manage critical patients.

Cases from chronic diseases like diabetes, hypertension and iron deficiency anemia to acute illnesses such as pneumonia, pleural effusion and heart failure, I collaborate closely with multidisciplinary teams to provide comprehensive medical management.

District Health Office (DHO) is a Public Sector Organization under the Government of Sindh. It supervises all the Public Sector Hospitals, Dispensaries and other Health Facilities in the respective district.

The dispensary serves as a Basic Health Unit with free of charge of regular Outpatient Clinic in a rural area. Cases were reported such as Pharyngitis, Viral Pneumonia, Allergic Rhinitis, Scabies, Fungal Infection, Osteoarthritis, Migraine, Diarrhea, Vomiting, Indigestion/Heartburn, Urinary Tract Infection, Candidiasis and Generalized Weakness.

Jinnah Postgraduate Medical Centre

Initially posted in HDU and was responsible to monitor and manage Covid-19 patients under the supervision of Chief Medical Officer/Registrar later posted at CVC (Corona Vaccination Centre) where conducted Covid-19 Vaccination and counselled patients on different types of vaccines, its benefits and adverse effects. I was given the responsibility to lead the team and dealt with concerns and vaccine related issues of the patients.

Rapid Response Team

Worked as a member of Rapid Response Team – RRT where Covid-19 PCR sampling and contact tracing of a positive case of Corona Virus was conducted. Visited various schools, offices and public places for Covid-19 pandemic awareness and conducted PCR sampling on a large scale.

MEDICAL OFFICER (RAJPUT GENERAL HOSPITAL)

As a medical officer in the surgery ward, I was responsible for ensuring the optimal care provided to patients undergoing surgical procedures. My role was defined as pre-operative assessments, took medical histories, performed physical examinations, ordered necessary investigations to assess their readiness for surgery and Informed OT in-charge, anesthetist and the surgeon before procedure. During surgeries, I assisted the surgical team and monitored patients' vital signs to ensure their safety and well-being throughout the procedure. Post-operatively, I closely monitored patients' recovery, pain management, complications, and follow-up care.

Effective communication with patients and their families is paramount, as I provided explanations, answered questions, and offered support to alleviate any concerns they may have regarding the surgical process and recovery.

Managed patients of Pre-eclampsia, Eclampsia, Gestational Diabetes, and was involved in the management of postpartum complications. Maintained Partogram and performed Spontaneous Vaginal Delivery (SVD), Assisted Cesarean Section (LSCS). Counselled patients on importance of Family Planning.

HOUSE OFFICER IN GENERAL SURGERY

Mornings started with reviewing surgical schedules, ensuring readiness for procedures, and conducting pre-operative assessments. Managed preoperative and postoperative patients in the ward. Assisted surgical team in an operating room. Involved in minor surgical procedures such as nail removal, excision of cutaneous lumps (sebaceous cyst, lipoma, and ganglion), removal of a foreign body, closure of wounds (stitches), incision and drainage of abscess and cauterization of warts. Post-operative care involved monitoring patients closely, managing pain, and addressing any complications promptly.

During my surgical rotation, familiarized with cases like Para umbilical and Inguinal hernia, Varicose Veins, Cholecystitis, Cholelithiasis, Hemorrhoids, Anal Fissure, Pilonidal sinus and Breast Fibro adenoma.
