MEDICINE (3 months)

I was able to grasp basics of clinical practice of Medicine. I acquainted myself with various diagnostic procedures like abdominal paracentesis, pleural fluid aspiration, lumber puncture, catheterization and naso-gastric intubation etc.

In addition to Internal Medicine, I spent 2 weeks each rotating through the specialized disciplines of Intensive Care Unit and attended "Specialty Clinics" held in the ward (Diabetic, Endocrinology and Rheumatology).

ACCIDENT & EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT (3 months)

As an Assistant Casualty Medical Officer in E.D. I took part in all routine activities like receiving and managing acute emergencies, clerking of patients and presentation of cases in ward rounds. I was able to grasp some basic principles of managing all kinds of emergencies, which include trauma and all acute medical, surgical, orthopedic and neurological cases besides poisoning and medicolegal cases.

Surgery and Allied (October 2023 – April 2024)

SURGERY (3 months)

As a house surgeon, I assisted in several surgical procedures like appendectomy, cholecystectomy, hernia repair and I&D. I also learned how to recognize and manage complications that may arise during surgery, such as bleeding, infection, and unexpected anatomical variations. Along with that I attended inpatient ward, various OPDs where I observed several cases related to breast, thyroid and abdomen pathology which required surgical interventions.

ORTHOPEDICS (3 months)

As an orthopedic intern, I had a clinical experience which includes taking patient histories, performing physical examinations, and learning to interpret diagnostic tests such as X-rays and MRI scans. I assisted in procedures like joint replacements, fracture repairs, arthroscopic surgeries which involves tasks such as retracting tissues, suturing incisions and implanting. I also gained experience in managing orthopedic injuries such as fractures, dislocations and soft tissue injury.
